The herbs and salads grown are top quality, with great care and attention given to their production at all times. They have very strict bio security and traceability protocols in place, and adhere to the highest of industry standards.

Situated in the beautiful Breckland area of Norfolk, the farm lends itself to salad and herb production. Originally laid out as a sporting estate in the early 20th century, the small sheltered fields and light sandy soils provide the perfect environment for these rather delicate crops.

Malcolm Kemp started farming at Kilverstone in 1979, and starting experimenting with growing basil in the early 1980's. Gradually practise made perfect and by 2003 the entire farm was down to herb and salad production. Malcolm was joined by his son David in 2003, and the company now supplies on average 50 tonnes of produce per week during the summer season.
